## Agricultural supplies

### **Description:**

Non-dangerous general agricultural supplies like seed, bagged grain, feed, fertilisers.

### What it is not:

- Bulk grain or fertilisers
- Dangerous goods

## Agriculture and farming

### **Description:**

Activities conducted in a farm or agricultural business but not transport of farming products for third parties. May include incidental transport of own goods.

### What it is not:

- Contract harvesting
- Transport of agricultural supplies





### Bloodstock

### **Description:**

Thoroughbred and racing horses, stud and prize animals.


### What it is not:

Livestock or poultry

## Bridge and dam works

### **Description:**

Construction, repair, maintenance and erection of bridges and dams.







## Building site products

### **Description:**

Products used in building sites such as steel beams and girders, roofing materials, trusses, timber frames, bricks, flooring, plaster, insulation, cladding, etc.

#### What it is not:

Building and demolition waste


# Bulk liquids (non-dangerous)

### **Description:**

Non-dangerous liquids carried in bulk tankers, for example fruit juice, molasses, vegetable oil, wine, water.

#### What it is not:

• Milk or dairy products



## Bulk milk and dairy

### **Description:**

Milk or dairy products carried in bulk tankers.

### What it is not:

· Packaged milk or dairy products

See: Wholesale and retail goods

## Bulk powdered goods

### **Description:**

Flour, cement, fly ash, etc. in bulk tankers.

### What it is not:

Bagged or packaged flour

See: Wholesale and retail goods

Not concrete

See: Pre-mix concrete



## Bus or coach: General route

### **Description:**

Public passengers over defined standard routes (usually <25km).

### What it is not:

 Transportation of school children, tour groups, charters or buses used in an ancillary manner to a primary transportation business



## Bus or coach: Scheduled service

### **Description:**

City-to-city and interstate.

### What it is not:

 Local general route services such as city buses

See: General route



### Bus or coach: School route

### **Description:**

Transporting children to and from school on a predetermined route.

### What it is not:

Charters, tours, scheduled services





## Bus or coach: Self-drive hire

### **Description:**

Fewer than 30 seats for dry hire, often for sports trips or school excursions.

#### What it is not:

 Charter services with supplied driver, intra- or interstate tours

## Bus or coach: Shuttle service

### **Description:**

Courtesy service for airport, hotel or mine transfers; hospitality such as RSL Club pick-up; allied health community service buses.

#### What it is not:

 School buses, tour coaches, scheduled services for paying customers



## Bus or coach: Tour or charter under 450km

## Bus or coach: Tour or charter over 450km

### **Description:**

Intrastate organised tours, often day trips for tourists, conferences.

### What it is not:

 Long distance tours over 450km interstate or intrastate

### **Description:**

Intra- and interstate organised tours for individuals travelling with a group e.g. Contiki, Insight, Trafalgar.

### What it is not:

 Self-hire or scheduled services, charter groups on day tours




### Caravans

### **Description:**

Transport of caravans.

### What it is not:

Cars, vehicles, boats, machinery or overdimensional fright



### **Description:**

Transport of cars, vehicles and boats.


### What it is not:

Towing and recovery services

See: Towing and recovery

Machinery or overdimensional freight





# Construction and civil engineering

### **Description:**

Mobile plant used in government and public infrastructure activities, including road and bridge works, and large construction activities such as high-rise, residential and public amenities works.

### What it is not:

Demolition, general earthmoving, landscaping or mining

### Containers

### **Description:**

Empty or full containers.

### What it is not:

• Refrigerated containers

See: <u>Refrigerated and chilled</u> goods



## Contract harvesting

### **Description:**

Anyone who generates an income from harvesting other people's crops, or who contracts harvesting equipment to others for income.

#### What it is not:

• Agriculture or farming

## Crane operations

### **Description:**

Mobile or tower crane operations.

#### What it is not:

 Crane arms mounted on vehicles should be added as on-hook cover



## Dangerous goods: Bulk

### **Description:**

Dangerous goods as defined by the **Australian Dangerous Goods Code** (ADGC) other than fuel carried in bulk (including waste).

Bulk quantities of dangerous goods (over 500L or 500kg) are placardable.

### What it is not:

 Packaged or bottled dangerous goods


## Dangerous goods: Fuel

### **Description:**

Transport of fuel such as petroleum, LPG, diesel, biodiesel, ethanol, aviation fuel, etc.

### What it is not:

 Packaged or bottled dangerous goods





## Dangerous goods: Packaged and bottled

### **Description:**

Small quantities of non-bulk dangerous goods as defined by the **ADGC**. These include chlorine, pool chemicals, peroxides, gases or corrosives that are not placardable in bulk quantities (over 500L or 500kg).

### What it is not:

Bulk dangerous goods

### Demolition

### **Description:**

Demolition of structures such as buildings.

### What it is not:

Transport of demolition or building-site waste





# Drilling and boring operations

### **Description:**

Commercial drilling and boring.


## Driver training

### **Description:**

Qualified training companies that use motor vehicles or mobile plant and machinery to provide formal driver training.

### What it is not:

 Learner or provisional drivers in the normal course of business, or hire and rentals





## Earthmoving and excavation

### **Description:**

Site preparation, land clearing, excavation and general earthmoving.

### What it is not:

Demolition, mining, pipe laying, drilling, boring or road construction

## Electrical and white goods

### **Description:**

Transport of electrical goods for wholesale or retail.

### What it is not:

Other wholesale or retail items





## Forestry and logging

### **Description:**

Operating plant and machinery in a forestry area.

### What it is not:

Transport of forestry products and logs



## Forestry products and logs

### **Description:**

Transport of products harvested from a forest such as logs, lumber, wood pulp, bark or seedlings.


### What it is not:

Operating plant or machinery in a forestry area

See: Forestry and logging

Sawn timber

See: Building site products



## Furniture removalist: Residential

### **Description:**

Professional or private delivery of home furniture.

### What it is not:

Delivery of furniture from a shop or warehouse to a residence or office

## Furniture removalist: Nonresidential


### **Description:**

Delivery of furniture from warehouses or shops to other destinations.

### What it is not:

Delivery of other wholesale or retail items





## Grain and fertiliser

### **Description:**

Bulk grain or fertiliser carried in tippers.

### What it is not:

• Bagged grain or fertiliser

See: Agricultural supplies

## Hire and rental

### **Description:**

The dry hire of vehicles, plant, machinery and equipment for a fee.

### What it is not:

 Wet hire of trucks, vehicles or plant and machinery where the insured provides employees to operate the equipment





## Hotmix and bitumen

### **Description:**

Hot asphalt or bitumen products used for roads, parking facilities and airport surfacing.

### Landscaping

### **Description:**

Using mobile plant for landscaping activities, including both large projects and small residential activities.

Equipment predominantly consists of mini excavators, skid steers (Bobcats), lawn mowers and rigid tippers.

### What it is not:

 Demolition, drilling, piling and boring, mining or road construction





## Livestock and poultry

### **Description:**

Pigs, sheep, cattle, goats, camels, donkeys, horses, chickens, turkeys, quail, ducks, geese, pheasants, emus, ostriches, etc.

#### What it is not:

 Thoroughbred and racing horses, stud and prize animals

See: Bloodstock

### Machinery


### **Description:**

Transport of machinery.

### What it is not:

 Machinery requiring an overdimensional placard





### Manufacturing

### **Description:**

Mobile plant used in manufacturing businesses (including food production).

### What it is not:

• Transportation or movement of manufactured goods

See: Wholesale and retail goods

### Mining: Coal

### **Description:**

Mining of coal and related activities.

### What it is not:

 Underground mining or the transport of coal



## Mining: Hard rock (not coal)

### **Description:**

Hard-rock mining such as for granite, gold, marble or diamonds.

#### What it is not:

Coal or underground mining

## Mining: Minerals

### **Description:**

Mining - but not transport of - minerals from a mine site.

#### What it is not:

Underground mining, mining of coal, mining of hard rock or transport of mining products on a road



## Mining: Underground

### **Description:**

Mining of any materials that principally takes place underground.

Please also ensure you confirm underground operations on the Motor High Risk Activities questions.

### What it is not:

Mining that takes place above ground


## Mining products: Coal


### **Description:**

Transport of coal directly from a mine.

### What it is not:

- Sand, soil or gravel
- Minerals, ore, metals, various stones, potash
- General civil tipping
- Dangerous goods





## Mining products: Non-coal

### **Description:**

Transport of the following items directly from a mine: minerals, ore, metals, various stones.

### What it is not:

- Sand, soil or gravel
- General civil tipping
- Dangerous goods

## Overdimensional and oversized freight


### **Description:**

Houses, fixed structures. buildings, yachts, boats, generators, mining equipment, etc. requiring a placard.

### What it is not:

Anything that is not overdimensional





## Parcels and post (courier)

### **Description:**

A courier carrying small parcels or general post.

### What it is not:

 Other freight types listed here, such as wholesale and retail goods

## Pipe laying and trenching

### **Description:**

Installing or laying piping such as sewerage lines or oil, water or chemicals pipelines.



## Pre-mix concrete

### **Description:**

Transport of wet concrete in agitators or for use in concrete pumps.

### What it is not:

 Bulk powdered goods like dry cement or ash

### Quarrying

### **Description:**

Mining rock, sand, gravel, limestone and the like in small quarries.

### What it is not:

 Mining coal or hard rock, or underground works





## Refrigerated and chilled goods

### **Description:**

Refrigerated produce in any form of refrigerated or chilled transport, including in refrigerated containers.

## Road construction and maintenance

### **Description:**

The construction, design, repair and maintenance of roads, their surfaces, driveways, parking lots and the like, including laying asphalt and hot bitumen.

### What it is not:

Pure site preparation

See: earthmoving/excavation





## Smash repairs and mechanics

### **Description:**

Recovery and towing of vehicles to or from the operator's smash or mechanical repair business.

### What it is not:

• Recovery of stranded, broken-down or damaged vehicles

## Soil, sand and gravel

### **Description:**

Transport of excavation and landscape materials such as soil, sand, aggregate, etc.

#### What it is not:

Building and demolition waste



## Specialty vehicles

### **Description:**

Transport of antiques, vintage or high-performance cars used for racing, stunts, etc.

#### What it is not:

• Circus, carnival operators or film industry



# Towing and recovery: Light

### **Description:**

Recovery and towing of stranded, broken-down or damaged light vehicles (i.e. cars and utilities).

### What it is not:

 Recovery of heavy vehicles or transport between repairers


## Towing and recovery: Heavy


### **Description:**

Recovery and towing of stranded, broken-down or damaged heavy vehicles (i.e. trucks and trailers), or mobile plant and equipment (e.g. excavators).

### What it is not:

 Recovery of light vehicles or transporting between repairers





## Tradesmen and builders

### **Description:**

Any tradesmen and builders.

### What it is not:

Tradesmen who perform other activities noted in this list, such as drilling and boring, earthmoving and excavation, or quarrying

## Warehousing and logistics

### **Description:**

Predominantly material handling equipment (such as forklifts and pallet jacks), and elevated work platforms used in the dry hire and machinery sales industries.

### What it is not:

- Transport and haulage operations
- Warehouse and storage operations not related to the construction and earthmoving industries





## Waste: Building and demolition

### **Description:**

General waste and unwanted materials collected from building and demolition sites such as bricks, plaster, asbestos, insulation, nails, wiring, tree stumps, etc.

### What it is not:

Waste carried in compactors

See: Waste: Compacted

Waste carried in skip bins or waste in tankers, soil, sand, gravel used for construction and landscaping process

See: Soil, sand and gravel

## Waste: Compacted

### **Description:**

Waste carried in garbage compactors such as household, green, and non-dangerous goods waste.

### What it is not:

Non-compacted waste





## Waste: Noncompacted and skip bins

### **Description:**

Skip bins, tankers carrying waste that is not dangerous goods.

### What it is not:

 Dangerous goods or compacted waste

## Wholesale and retail goods

### **Description:**

Transport of goods related to the wholesale and retail industries, for example palletised goods, non-refrigerated produce, clothing, supermarket goods, hardware and alcohol.

### What it is not:

• Refrigerated goods
